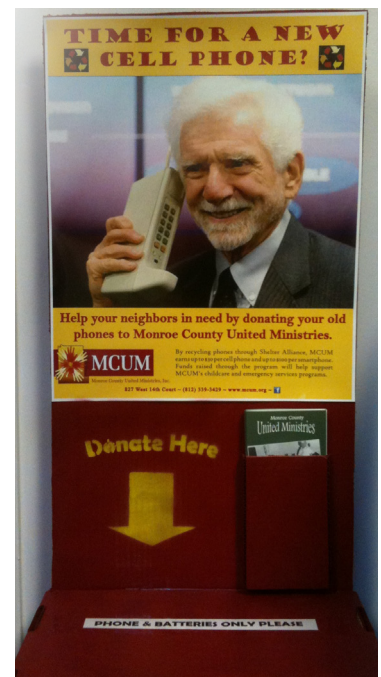
So rather than adding to your graveyard of electronics, donate your unwanted cell phones to MCUM!

Recycling for a Cause

By recycling phones through Shelter Alliance, an organization with zero landfill and no-export policies, MCUM is paid per phone (\$0.50 - \$50, depending on age and condition). Your active participation means greater revenue for MCUM's efforts to provide affordable childcare and basic needs assistance in Monroe County.

Preparing for Recycling

3 things to remember:

- Terminate your service.
- Clear the phone's memory of stored information.
- Remove your SIM card.

Where to Recycle

Phones can be donated at Opportunity House, MCUM's offices at 827 W. 14th Ct. (next to Tri-North), or anywhere other items are collected for MCUM.
